OTHER THINGS TO KNOW:

Photo format should be the *largest* resolution RAW format your camera can process.

On average, the 605 team edits 25-40 of images per article. Please try to not to deliver more than 200 images.

Aim to shoot a healthy mix of vertical and horizontal images, especially when capturing food and/or portraits. This gives 605 more flexibility with the article layout.

Payment is \$50 per shoot if in the same town and should take roughly 30-60 minutes. More is discussed for travel.

605 asks that you please:

- Represent yourself professionally when on set for a 605 photo session and be punctual.
- Meet deadlines and communicate any progress with the 605 team.
- Submit your unedited RAW photos to your assigned freelance Dropbox.
- Don't share images with anyone outside of the 605 team. 605 reserves the right to sell the galleries after the issue is made public.



HERE IS WHAT IS NEEDED FOR A SUCCESSFUL FEATURE:

General Rules:

- + Detail shots of the location/subject, including products, décor, etc.
- Profile/Lifestyle shots of the subject (posed and un-posed).
- Interior and exterior (if applicable) shots of the location.

Home Shoots:

- + 2-3 wide angle images of main rooms (18mm or wider if possible)
- + All items under General Rules

605 Profile:

- ◆ 2-3 Strong profile or lifestyle images.
- + 2-5 ambient/detail shot for web.

Bar/Restaurant Shoots:

- + Photos of 3-4 food menu items. Ideally a mix of entrees, appetizers, and desserts.
- + Photos of 2-3 cocktail/beverage items.
- + Photos of the staff (posed and un-posed).
- + All items under general rules.

605 Brewers:

- +1 strong horizontal food/ drink shot - utilize plenty of dead space to leave room for text.
- + 2-5 ambient/detail shots for web.
